This request form serves as your request to the Colorado County Appraisal District that you are consenting and agreeing to receive certain notices via email as required under statute.

Please be advised that under the *Texas Property Tax Code (PTC) Sec 1.086*, **ONLY** your **residential property** that is your **principal residence** qualifies for notices contained in *PTC Sec 1.086(a)* to be delivered via electronic mail (E-Mail).

By signing this request, you are affirming that you own this **residential property** and that it is occupied as your **principal residence**, you are providing a valid email address, and you are agreeing to receiving by email the following notices:

- a change in value of the property
- the eligibility of the property for an exemption; or
- the grant, denial, cancellation, or other change in the status of an exemption or exemption application applicable to the property.

Once you have completed and submitted this request, the chief appraiser is no longer required to send the same notices by regular first-class mail. This request will also remain in effect until a **written revocation** is filed with the chief appraiser.
